



Onetangi Community Hall COVID Protection Framework Guidelines

To protect all who attend any event at the hall and to comply with all applicable government regulations, the following guidelines will be in effect for any individual or group using the Onetangi Community Hall:

- All attendees, age 12 and over, at any event using the hall (including the outside area) will need to provide proof of double vaccination or an official Ministry of Health approved exemption. This proof of vaccination or exemption must be provided only by the use of the official New Zealand My Vaccine Pass.
- Event organisers must check the vaccination status of all attendees before they enter the hall by visually checking the approved My Vaccine Pass either on paper or in electronic form. The use of the NZ Pass Verifier (supplied by the Ministry of Health-iOS and Android) is suggested.
- For those individuals that you are not personally familiar with, you will also need to check a photo ID to verify the identity of the individual presenting the My Vaccine Pass.
- For repeating events, you only need to check the My Vaccine Pass at the first visit of the attendee, if you record that the individual has presented their Pass along with the Pass's expiration date.
- All attendees must scan in using the NZ Covid Tracer App or by providing their details on the Contact Tracing Register (copies will be made available to you). The event organiser should maintain a copy of the Contact Tracing Register.
- Request that all attendees use hand sanitiser upon entry (provided for you) and wear a face mask when practical.
- Where possible, keep all windows and doors open (including those on to the back deck area).
- At the conclusion of each session, please wipe down "high touch" surfaces (tabletops, light switches, toilets, taps, door handles, etc. with the provided disinfectant and paper towels.
